

NORTH CAROLINA PSYCHOLOGY BOARD
Open Session Minutes
March 4, 2020
Teleconference

The North Carolina Psychology Board met in a called meeting via teleconference on March 4, 2020.

General

At the February 27, 2020 Board meeting, the Board instructed staff to revise proposed changes to Rules .2006 and .2008 as a result of the Rules Review Commission's decision that the Psychology Practice Act required Licensed Psychological Associates to receive some degree of supervision. The Board reviewed the revised rules and, following discussion, approved the rules, as amended, to be submitted to the Commission for review and approval.
