ANNUAL REPORT

June 30, 2018

This report is submitted in accordance with G.S. § 90-270.10. The report covers the activities of the North Carolina Psychology Board for the period of July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2018.

Robert W. Hill, Ph.D., ABPP, and Stacie L. MacDonald, M.A., were appointed to serve additional terms until June 30, 2020. Officers for the fiscal year were Robert W. Hill, Ph.D., ABPP, Chairperson and, Kristine M. Herfkens, Ph.D., ABPP, Vice-Chairperson.

The Board held four regularly scheduled face-to-face meetings and two teleconference meetings, as follows:

One administrative hearing was held during the fiscal year in the following matter:
Lauren Kavanaugh-Wallace, Psy.D., February 8, 2018.

The following action was taken or confirmed pursuant to G.S. § 90-270.15 and G.S. § 90-270.16:

Edwards, Christopher, Ph.D. - CONSENT ORDER was approved and signed on May 10, 2018. Respondent admits that the described conduct violates N.C. Gen. Stat. §§ 90-270.15(a)(10), (a)(19), (a)(22) of the North Carolina Psychology Practice Act and Standards 3.09 of the Ethical Principles of Psychologist and Code of Conduct. Respondent's license is SUSPENDED for a period of 90 days, provided the Board approves his release from the suspension. During the suspension, Respondent shall undergo a fitness for practice evaluation. If the Board determines Respondent is fit to practice, Respondent shall remain on PROBATION for the longer of one year or until he completes an independent study and receives supervision for the performance of 30 evaluations. Respondent is assessed \$300.00 in costs

Hammond, Marsha, Ph.D. - CONSENT ORDER was approved and signed on May 10, 2018. Respondent admits that the described conduct constitutes violations of N.C. Gen. Stat. §§ 90-270.15(a)(10), (a)(11), (a)(15) & (a)(17) of the North Carolina Psychology Practice Act, and constitutes violations of Standards 2.01, 3.04, 3.05, 3.10, 4.05 & 6.01, of the Ethical Principles of Psychologists and Code of Conduct. Respondent's license is CENSURED. Respondent shall complete a minimum of six to eight hours of tutorials. In addition, for a period of one year consisting of 1500 hours of practice in psychology, whichever takes longer to occur, Respondent shall receive face to face supervision at a minimum of one one-hour session per week during any week in which she practices psychology.

Kavanaugh-Wallace, Lauren, Psy.D. – FINAL DECISION was approved and signed on May 10, 2018. Respondent's license is hereby REVOKED. Respondent's conduct constitutes a violation

of N.C.GEN. STAT. Sec. 90-270.15(a)(10), §§. 90-270.15(a)(11), (14), (15), (17), and (20); 21 NCAC 54 .2803 and .2805; and Standards 2.05, 3.04, 3.06, 3.08, 3.10, 4.01, 4.02, 6.01, 9.01, 9.03, 9.06, 9.10, 10.01, and 10.10 of the Ethical Principles of Psychologists and Code of Conduct. The Respondent shall pay the costs of this disciplinary proceeding in accordance with 21 NCAC 54.1605, calculated as \$ 1,650.00.

Martin, Elizabeth M., Ph.D. - CONSENT ORDER was approved and signed on August 3, 2017. Respondent acknowledges that the described conduct constitutes violations of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 7B-301, duty to report abuse/neglect; N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-270.15(a)(10) of the North Carolina Psychology Practice Act; and Standards 4.05(b) & 6.01 of the Ethical Principles of Psychologists and Code of Conduct. This action taken by the Board in this Consent Order shall constitute Remedial Action pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-270.15(b) and shall not constitute disciplinary action. Respondent shall successfully complete a minimum of four hours of tutorials regarding mandatory reporting requirements regarding suspected abuse/neglect: how Respondent's behavior resulted in this action taken by the Board; Respondent's plan of action to prevent the reoccurrence of the behavior and best practices in documentation. Respondent also is assessed \$300 in costs.

Mauldin, Anne. L., Ph.D. - CONSENT ORDER was approved and signed on November 9, 2017. Respondent admits that the described conduct constitutes violations of N.C. Gen. Stat. §§ 90-270.15(a)(10), (a)(15) & (a)(17) of the North Carolina Psychology Practice Act, and constitutes violations of Standards 3.10, 4.01, 4.05 & 6.01 of the Ethical Principles of Psychologists and Code of Conduct. Respondent shall successfully complete a minimum of six to eight hours of tutorials regarding proper documentation; informed consent; assessment and diagnosis; confidentiality requirements for psychologists; how Respondent's behavior resulted in this action taken by the Board; Respondent's plan of action to prevent the recurrence of the behavior; and general ethical conduct. Respondent also is assessed \$300.00 in costs.

Moler, Christina L., Psy.D. - CONSENT ORDER was approved and signed on November 9, 2017. Respondent admits that the described conduct constitutes violations of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-270.15(a)(10) of the North Carolina Psychology Practice Act, and 21 N.C.A.C. 54 .2002(b)(4) of the North Carolina Psychology Board rules. Respondent further admits that the described conduct constitutes violations Standards 3.04, 3.05, 3.06, 4.01, and 4.05(a) of the Ethical Principles of Psychologists and Code of Conduct. The license of Respondent is hereby REPRIMANDED. As of the date of the Consent Order, Respondent's license is suspended because she has not renewed it. In order for Respondent to reinstate her suspended license or to obtain a new license in the future she shall successfully complete a minimum of eight to ten hours of tutorials regarding confidentiality requirements for psychologists and appropriate boundaries with patients and their significant others/family members, and general ethical issues for a psychologist. Respondent also is assessed \$300.00 in costs.

Norris, David, Ph.D. - CONSENT ORDER was approved and signed on May 10, 2018. Respondent admits that the described conduct constitutes violations of N.C. Gen. Stat. §§ 90-270.15(a)(10), (a)(15) & (a)(17) of the North Carolina Psychology Practice Act, and constitutes a violation of Standard 6.01 of the Ethical Principles of Psychologists and Code of Conduct. Respondent shall complete a minimum of four to six hours of tutorials. For a period of one year consisting of a minimum 1500 hours of practice in psychology, Respondent shall receive face to face supervision for a minimum of one one-hour sessions per week during any week in which he practices psychology. This Consent Order shall not constitute disciplinary action. Respondent is assessed \$300.00 in costs.

Sloan, Jerry, Ph.D. - CONSENT ORDER was approved and signed on February 9, 2018. Respondent admits that the described conduct constitutes violations of N.C. Gen. Stat. §§ 90-270.15(a)(10), (a)(14) & (a)(15) of the North Carolina Psychology Practice Act, and constitutes violations of Standards 3.10, 9.01(a), 9.02(a) & (b), 9.03(a), 9.06 and 9.08(a) of the Ethical Principles of Psychologists and Code of Conduct. Respondent's license is REPRIMANDED. Respondent shall complete a minimum of six to eight hours of tutorials regarding the proper use of testing instruments; requirements for updates to testing instruments; general testing guidance, including re-administering a test that has previously been administered; informed consent requirements; how Respondents conduct resulted in this action taken by the Board; Respondent's plan of action to prevent the recurrence of the behavior which resulted in Board action; and general ethical conduct. For a period of one year, Respondent shall receive face-to-face supervision with a psychologist licensed in North Carolina at a minimum of two, one-hour sessions per month during any month in which Respondent practices psychology, regardless of the number of hours of practice. Respondent also is assessed \$300.00 in costs.

Wynns, Kristin, Ph.D. - CONSENT ORDER was approved and signed on September 25, 2017. Respondent understands that the if the Board found the described conduct to be true it would constitute violations of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-270.15 (a)(10) of the North Carolina Psychology Practice Act, and Standards 3.04, 3.08 and 6.04 of the Ethical Principles of Psychologists and Code of Conduct. The action taken by the Board pursuant to the Consent Order constitutes Remedial Action, as specified in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-270.15(b). It does not constitute disciplinary action. Respondent shall complete a minimum of four to six hours of tutorials regarding high conflict divorce; clear informed consent; and professional conduct, as specified in the NC Psychology Practice Act and in the Ethical Principles of Psychologists and Code of Conduct; how Respondent's behavior resulted in this action taken by the Board; Respondent's plan of action to prevent the recurrence of the behavior; and general ethical conduct.

- sought fee increases to enable the Board to fulfill its statutory mandate to protect the public from incompetent, unethical, and unprofessional practice
- sought establishment of inactive licensure status
- initiated digitizing licensure files
- initiated development of new licensee database
- initiated development of online supervision report system
- continued development of an online state exam
- continued development of online license application system
- continued upgrade of IT systems and equipment

In addition to continuing to perform its routine tasks in connection with protecting the public, major objectives for the 2018-2019 fiscal year are as follows:

- address budgetary and long-range planning issues
- continue to seek fee increases to enable the Board to fulfill its statutory mandate to protect the public from incompetent, unethical, and unprofessional practice
